The Council held their first meeting following the AGM on 2nd March, for which the following highlights were discussed:

- There was agreement to proceed with developing a resource to help Luing breeders with marketing Luing beef direct to the consumer.
- Premier Sale Review the Society will conduct a post-sale vendor survey to help inform around future sales.
- Council decided not to pursue a joint presence with the Welsh Simmental Club at the Royal Welsh Show.
- The Breed Development Committee will discuss introducing an age-graduated schedule for testicle measurements (pertaining to bull inspections in the autumn).
